

female to officer VanderJagt who took control of her and eventually handcuffed her with Officer Brake. I ran around to the end of the building where the hallway would have emptied out into the courtyard and realized that there was no way for the male to exit the hallway and that there were only two sets of footprints in the snow which were caused by officers Stanley and Stone who were seen crossing the courtyard. After realizing that there was no way for the party to escape I went to the southeast corner to be sure that the party did not get inside another apartment and escape via a back window. As I rounded the south end of the apartment row I heard several dozen shots fired and saw two rounds exit the south side window where the suspect had been seen trying to get in. People started airing that an officer was down and we needed a ambulance code 10. At that time I took a position of cover watching the east side of the apartments behind a chimney. After hearing several dozen more shots fired it was quiet for apx. 30 minutes when Sgt. Jones told me to exit my position and go to the northern end of the complex where I re-joined Officer Brake behind Officer Dymonds car which was on the north end of the row where the suspects were seen. We remained there probably another 30 minutes until Sgt. Hemphill told us to go to the command post. I stood by there until the crime lab took my picture and counted the rounds in my weapon. After that I was told to report to homicide with officer Golston. We responded to homicide where Det. Bancroft got me started on the computer to give my statement.

I have read the foregoing statement and the facts contained therein are true to the best of my knowledge and belief. I do not maintain that it contains all of the facts or details of the incident, but only those facts about which I have been asked.
